



Meet the GateE Project

The GateE project envisions a future where women play an active and leading role in Europe's green energy transition. Its mission is to increase women's participation and leadership in the energy sector as it evolves toward sustainability.



To achieve this, GateE will make vocational education and training (VET) more inclusive by adapting curricula at EQF levels 3–4 and creating strong mentorship opportunities.

GateE also focuses on removing systemic barriers that limit women's access to green energy careers, with special attention to marginalised groups. Through policy frameworks, targeted educational initiatives, and tailored support networks, the project promotes empowerment and equal opportunities across Europe.

GateE applies a Quadruple Helix Innovation Model, which focuses on industry, government, civil society, and self-empowerment to design interconnected actions in awareness, policy, training, and career support.

By 2027, GateE will deliver mentorships, training, and community programs that equip women and professionals with new skills and opportunities. Its long-term impact will be sustained through an Educational and Cooperation Platform and an Observatory for Gender Equality in Green Energy.
